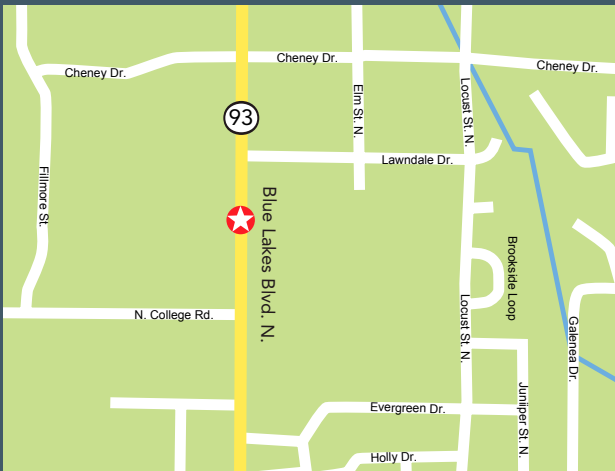

**FROM EAST OR WEST:** From I-84, take exit 173 and travel south on Hwy 93 for 3 miles. Cross Snake River Canyon, then pass through 2 stoplights, the second of which is at the Blue Lakes Blvd./Poleline Road intersection. The hotel located is approximately 1/2 mile down on the right side of the road.

**FROM NORTH:** Traveling on Hwy 93, cross Snake River Canyon then pass through 2 stoplights, the second of which is at the Blue Lakes Blvd. /Poleline Road intersection. The hotel is located approximately 1/2 mile down on the right side of the road.

**FROM SOUTH:** Traveling north on Hwy 93, take the Twin Falls exit from onto Hwy 30; follow Interstate 84 and Hwy 93 signs through town. The hotel is located on Blue Lakes Blvd. N.

**FROM THE TWIN FALLS AIRPORT:** Take road out of the the parking area for 4 miles, and curve right over Rock Creek Canyon onto Shoshone Street. Turn left onto Blue Lakes Blvd. N. Continue approximately 3 miles, and the hotel is located on the left side of the road.

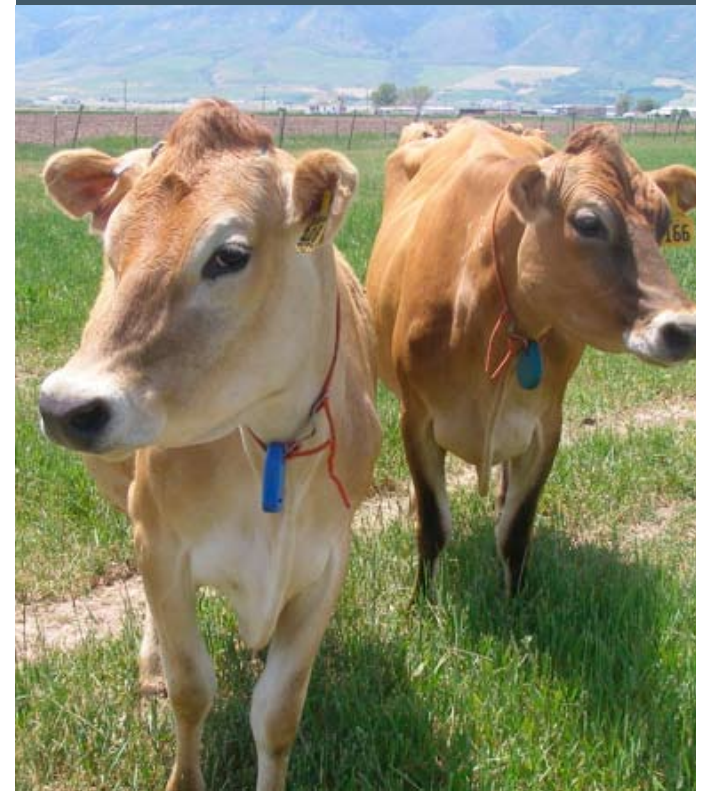
