USDA Release: Ag Secretary Announces Funding for Value Added Producer Grants

Aug. 26, 2009 - Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack announced that USDA will soon be accepting applications for grants to assist agricultural producers seeking to add value to the commodities they produce. Approximately \$18 million will be awarded nationwide. USDA plans to award planning grants of up to \$100,000 and working capital grants of up to \$300,000 to successful applicants. Applicants are encouraged to propose projects that use existing agricultural products in non-traditional ways or merge agricultural products with technology in creative ways. Businesses of all sizes may apply, but priority will be given to operators of small and medium-sized family farms - those with average, annual gross sales of less than \$700,000.

Conservation Stewardship Program Announced

Agriculture Deputy Secretary Kathleen Merrigan has announced the first farmer sign up period for the new Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP). The CSP will make payments to farmers for maintaining existing conservation practices and for adopting additional practices on cropland, grassland, improved pasture, rangeland, non-industrial private forestland and tribal lands. Payment will also be made for adopting resource conserving crop rotations.

Farmers can submit applications at their local Natural Resource Conservation District offices between August 10th and September 30th to be considered for this 12.8 million acre sign up. Enrollment for the new CSP is nationwide and the program is not limited to certain watersheds. [learn more...](#)

International: Upcoming Organic Regulations in Korea

The Republic of Korea (ROK) Ministry of Food Agriculture Forestry and Fisheries (MIFAFF) has developed organic standards which are scheduled to take effect on January 1st 2010 after which all organic products in Korea must be certified to their regulation by a certifier accredited by the ROK. The ROK has recently agreed that organic products in transit to Korea and in the distribution/retail stream before December 31st 2009 may remain until their expiration date. OTCO clients exporting to Korea can do so until this date. As written there are some significant challenges with the Korean regulations, which will prevent organic products from entering the Korean market when they take effect. [learn more...](#)

Shipping Organic Products to Taiwan and the TM-11

A new agreement struck between the USDA and the officials of Taiwan have made it possible to continue to ship your organic products to Taiwan. In this agreement there is a requirement that the Accredited Certification Body issue a load specific certificate, commonly referred to as the TM-11. For those that have been shipping product to Japan this is a familiar document and process. If you are currently shipping product to Taiwan or are looking at doing so in the future please contact the OTCO office to learn more about requesting a TM-11 for Taiwan. [learn more...](#)
