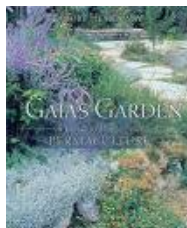

Through collaborative education and research from organizations such as Oregon Tilth and of course, the farmers, Organic Seed Alliance continues to promote the ethical development and stewardship of the genetic resources of agricultural seed. Oregon Tilth and several others worked with Organic Seed Alliance to create a guide and resource manual for on-farm organic seed research and variety trialing, published in the summer of 2007. So far on this endeavor, 17 of Oregon Tilth's certified farms have chosen to receive this dual-certification, it is somewhat of a new partnership that Salmon-Safe and Oregon Tilth hope to expand on.
