



## CHRIS SCHREINER CEO, Oregon Tilth

Chris Schreiner has over 27 years of experience in the organic sector. He grew up working on his family's fourth-generation, 200-acre iris farm in Oregon's Willamette Valley.

After completing his undergraduate degree, he worked on a small organic farm that grew specialty crops sold directly to local restaurants and natural food stores.

Since 1998, Chris has been with Oregon Tilth. As Farm Program Coordinator, he managed the organic certification process for over 400 farms. As Quality Control Director, he handled policy analysis and USDA National Organic Program accreditation.

Since 2009, Chris has been Oregon Tilth's top executive. He has developed innovative partnerships with Oregon State University and the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service to expand resources for organic producers.

In 2014, Chris served on the Oregon Governor's Task Force on Genetically Engineered Agriculture. He also co-chaired the National Sustainable Agriculture Coalition's Research, Education and Extension Committee for six years.
